Introduction

Your privacy is important to us. This Cookie Notice explains how we use cookies and similar tracking technologies on our Website. It explains what these technologies are and why we use them, as well as your rights to control our use of them.

When we say "**you**" or "**your**" in this Cookie Notice, we mean visitors to our Website. When we use "**GSAM**", "**we**", "**us**" or "**ours**", we are referring to Goldman Sachs Asset Management. Whenever we refer to "**Website**" we mean <https://www.gsam.com>

What are cookies?

Cookies are small data files that are placed on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. Cookies are widely used by website owners in order to make their websites work, or to work more efficiently, as well as to provide aggregated reporting information.

Cookies set by a website owner (in this case, GSAM) are called "first party cookies". Only the website owner can access the first party cookies it sets. Cookies set by parties other than the website owner are called "third party cookies". Third party cookies enable third party features or functionality to be provided on or through the website (such as advertising or social sharing). The parties that set these third party cookies can recognise your device both when it visits the Website and also when it visits other websites that have partnered with them. On the Website we use both first- and third- party cookies.

Why do we use cookies?

We use cookies for several reasons. Some cookies are required for technical reasons in order for our Website to operate. For example, if you want to access a secure area of the Website we need to check you have authority to do so. These are known as "Essential cookies". Other cookies are required to make the Website function well in the way you would like it to. We refer to these all as "Cookies that improve your experience". A third category is "Cookies that help with advertising". We use these cookies to help us tailor our adverts based your interaction with our Website.

Which cookies do we use?

The specific types of first and third party cookies served through our Website and the purposes they perform are described in the table below:

Essential cookies: We use these cookies to make sure our website works as quickly and smoothly as possible. They help us protect your account from fraud and provide you with secure login. What about other tracking technologies, like web beacons?

Cookies are not the only way to recognise or track visitors to a website or their interactions with us. We may use other, similar technologies from time to time, like web beacons (sometimes called "tracking pixels" or "clear gifs"). These are tiny graphics files that contain a unique identifier that enable us to recognise when someone has visited our Websites or opened an e-mail that we have sent them or clicked on a link within that e-mail. This allows us, for example, to monitor the traffic patterns of users from one page within our Website to another or to measure the success of e-mail marketing campaigns.

Do you serve targeted advertising?

We use cookies that help with advertising to help us tailor our adverts based on things you've interacted with on our website. If you don't turn these cookies on, you may still see our adverts on other sites but they won't be tailored to you. We don't display adverts from other companies on our website.

How can you control cookies?

You have the right to decide whether to accept or reject non-essential cookies. You can exercise your cookie preferences through our Cookie Preference Tool (link included on the footer of the Website).

You can also set or amend your web browser controls to accept or refuse all cookies. If you choose to reject all cookies, you may still use our Website though your access to some functionality and areas of our website will be restricted. As the means by which you can refuse cookies through your web browser controls vary from browser-to-browser, you should visit your browser's help menu for more information.
